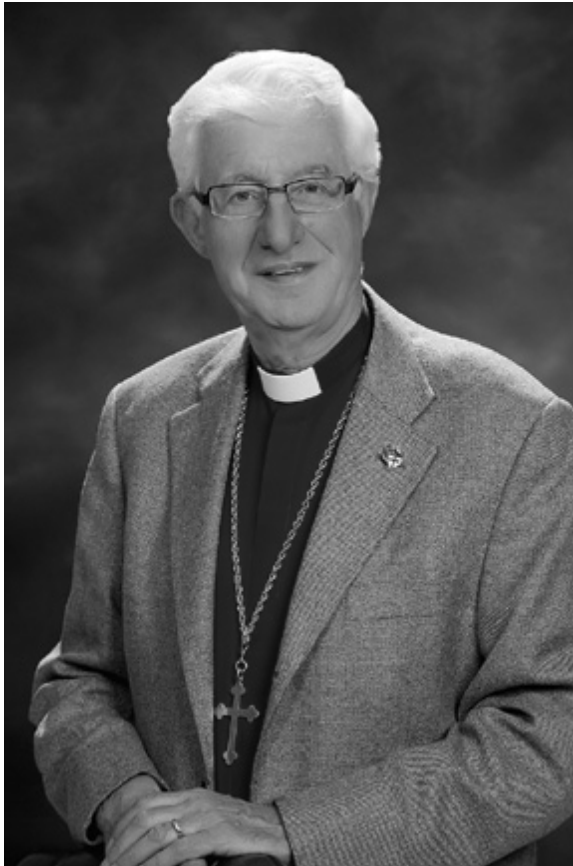

THE RIGHT REV. MALCOLM
HARDING

Bishop Suffragan (retired) of
The Anglican Network
In Canada

Born in England. Cradle Anglican. Came with my family to Canada (Windsor, Ontario) in 1947. A member of St. Paul's Anglican Church, Windsor. Studied Arts and Theology at Huron College, University of Western Ontario, London, ON. B.A.: 1959. L. Th.: 1962.

Married Marylou Richards, 1962. Three children, four grandchildren.

Ordained Deacon: 1962. Served briefly in the Diocese of Fredericton, five point rural parish. Decided to explore social work. Worked for the Children's Aid Society of Rainy River in Fort Frances, ON. Studied social work at the University of Manitoba. B.S.W.: 1965. M.S.W.: 1966. Worked for the Manitoba Department of Health and Social Development for 7 years, in Dauphin, Manitoba. The last 5 years as District Office Supervisor.

Became exposed to the Charismatic Renewal in the late 60's. Experienced a further conversion, and a new enthusiasm to serve our Lord. Ordained a priest in 1973 in Dauphin, MB. Served in a multi-point rural parish 5 years, and an urban parish for 14 years (Diocese of Brandon.)

Elected Bishop of Brandon in 1992. Retired in July 2001. Began serving as Ambassador for Anglican Renewal Ministries in September, 2001. This ministry extended for several years.

On November 18, 2007 I relinquished my ministry as Bishop in the Anglican Church of Canada and was received by Bishop Don Harvey, Moderator of the Anglican Network in Canada, acting under the authority of Archbishop Greg Venables and the Anglican Province of the Southern Cone into the Anglican Network in Canada. I served until July 30/09 as Bishop Suffragan in ANiC. Since then I have made myself available on a part time basis for teaching on parish renewal and church growth.
